AED Placement in Schools

Louisiana Revised Statutes – **40:1137.3.** Persons in possession of AEDs; training, testing, and notification requirements; manufacturer responsibility; possession required

- Outlines that any person or entity that possesses an AED shall ensure that the AED is maintained and tested, has been prescribed by a licensed provider, that expected users receive appropriate training and there is appropriate EMS notification/activation
 - *E.*(2)(a) each high school shall have an AED on its premises, if funding is available, subject to appropriation.
 - *E.(2)(b)* outlines the AED on premises requirements for any high school within a parish with a population between 200,000 and 250,000

Louisiana Administrative Code - § 6103 General Provisions

• *A. (5a) Each high school that participates in interscholastic athletics shall have an AED on its premises, if funding is available*

School Staff CPR/AED Training

Louisiana Revised Statutes – **40:1137.3.** Persons in possession of AEDs; training, testing, and notification requirements; manufacturer responsibility; possession required

• Expected AED users regularly receive appropriate training in CPR and in the use of an AED from any nationally recognized course in CPR and AED use.

Louisiana Revised Statutes – 9:2793. Gratuitous service at scene of emergency; limitation on liability

• Uses key verbiage to describe liability for any civil damages for persons rendering emergency care, including the use of an AED.
