Pennsylvania Statues, 24 P.S. § 14-1423. Automatic external defibrillators

- Describes mandated requirements for the Department of Education of the Commonwealth by providing:
 - o guidelines for establishing an automatic external defibrillator (AED) program to assist school entities and nonpublic schools in making AEDs available
 - o guidelines for biennial bidding for the cost of AEDs and other equipment and the eligibility requirements to purchase subsequent AEDS
 - o training requirements for school personnel who are expected to use the AED
 - o annual reporting requirements specific to AEDs in each school building

Good Samaritan Laws

Pennsylvania Statues, 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 8331.2. Good Samaritan civil immunity for use of automated external defibrillator

- Uses key verbiage to describe liability in civil damages for individuals who are trained to use an AED
- Outlines requirements for persons who acquire an AED for use
 - Expected users to receive specific training
 - Maintenance and testing the AED is performed according to manufacturer's quidelines
