AED Placement in Schools

Texas Education Code, § 38.017 EDUC. Availability of Automated External Defibrillator

- Mandates that each school district make available at least one AED at each campus
- Also specifies availability during any University Interscholastic League athletic competition held on campus
- Specifies at least one campus or district employee trained in the proper us of the AED be present any time a substantial number of district students are present

School Staff CPR/AED Training

Texas Education Code, § 22.902 EDUC. Instruction Related To Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Use of Automated External Defibrillator

- Outlines annual requirements for instruction in principals and techniques of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an AED for district employees and volunteers
- Also specifies who must receive and maintain certification in the use of an AED

School Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or AED Drills

Texas Education Code, § 38.018 EDUC. Procedures Regarding Response to Cardiac Arrest

• Specifies that each school district and private school (if they receive an AED) must develop safety procedures for a district or school employee or student to follow in responding to a medical emergency involving a cardiac arrest
