AED Placement

Oregon Revised Statutes -- § 339.345 - Requirement to have automated external defibrillator.

Each K-12 private and public school campus must have at least one AED easily accessible with clear signage.

CPR/AED Training for staff and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Oregon Revised Statutes -- § 339.345 - Requirement to have automated external defibrillator.

Each K-12 schools are required to have CERP that is practicable and align with core elements established by a national organization focused on emergency cardiovascular care.

AED Placement

Oregon Revised Statutes -- § 339.345 - Requirement to have automated external defibrillator.

Each K-12 school is required to have an AED that is accessible during athletic practices and competitions at school

CPR/AED Training for coaches and/or Cardiac Emergency Response Plans (CERP) and/or Emergency Action Plans (EAP)

Oregon Revised Statutes -- § 339.345 - Requirement to have automated external defibrillator.

Each K-12 school is required to have CERP that is in place at both school and athletic events. This includes requirements for every coach, as defined in ORS 336.485, and other appropriate staff, to be trained in CPR/AED use.
