Project ADAM began in 1999 after the death of Adam Lemel, a 17-year-old Whitefish Bay, WI, high school student who collapsed and died while playing basketball.

Project ADAM is a now national program comprised of 38 program sites in 29 states working collaboratively to save lives by empowering schools and communities to be prepared for a sudden cardiac arrest.

Each year we host a national meeting where program coordinators and medical directors converge to discuss best practices and ideas through our work in advocacy, education and preparedness as we work to make schools and communities Heart Safe. The meeting will be held in person by Youth Heart Watch at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, an affiliate of Project ADAM®.
